E-Mail Registration

- 1 Select the 00_NAGOYA_free_Wi-Fi, 01_NAGOYA_free_Wi-Fi or
02_NAGOYA_free_Wi-Fi SSID in your device's Wi-Fi settings and
open your internet browser.
- 2 To log-in with e-mail, tap the “Log-in with e-mail” button.
- 3 Type in your e-mail address and tap “Send” to receive a confirmation
e-mail.
- 4 Within 5 minutes, tap the URL sent to your e-mail address to
complete the registration.
- 5 You can now use the Internet!

Social Networking Account Registration

02_NAGOYA_free_Wi-Fi SSID in your device's Wi-Fi settings and
